



## Domestic Violence Case Manager, Intensive Support

### The Opportunity

Our Crisis Accommodation Program has a full time opportunity for a Case Manager to join their vital service on a 12 month fixed term basis, starting in December 2020. Case Managers provide specialised case management and crisis support responses, and intensive outreach support with a focus on supporting families to move into alternative safe accommodation within 30 days.

### Key accountabilities of the role will include

- Actively contribute to securing safe pathways for women and children into and out of the crisis beds program, including the provision of intensive case management and crisis intervention that urgently responds to immediate client safety needs and pathways into safe accommodation;
- Undertake risk assessments and safety planning to promote the ongoing safety of women and children;
- Conduct initial needs assessments, and implement quality case plans in consultation with clients, and monitor and review client case plans to support ongoing safety;

### Essential Criteria

- A Degree or Diploma in Social Work, Social Sciences, Community Services, Human Services, Health Sciences and /or experience commensurate with the position.
- Significant knowledge and experience in the provision of case management responses and casework interventions.
- Sound knowledge and experience in crisis intervention.
- Knowledge of the particular needs of women and children affected by domestic and/or family violence.
