We are looking for candidates seeking a regular base roster and the flexibility be called on to work adhoc shifts in addition to their base roster to cover colleagues on leave.

The Work

Domestic & Family specialists perform the following duties:

- Conduct risk assessments and establish client needs;
- Provide practical & planned support options and responses to clients in crisis situations;
- Develop and implement crisis response and safety plans for women and children, including short term crisis accommodation, or options to remain in the home safely.
- liaise with key stakeholders to arrange accommodation and support
- arrange practical assistance for women and their children entering into safe accommodation

What you need

Only applicants meeting the following essential criteria below will be considered:

- Experience providing crisis intervention in a domestic violence or related setting;
- Understanding of risk assessments and safety management strategies;
- Strong interpersonal skills, & initiative to problem solve and initiate planned responses;
- The ability to do shift work to a 24/7 roster, including 1 night shift and weekend per fortnight
- A current drivers licence, and be eligible for, or hold a DHS Working with Children Check and National Police Clearance;
- Qualifications in Social Work, Community Services, and/or commensurate experience with the position
- Fully vaccinated with TGA approved COVID-19 vaccination or hold a valid medical exemption authorised by the Chief Public Officer
